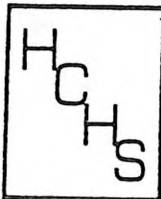

THE LEO ARTHUR YOUNG FAMILY COLLECTION

1. THE COLLECTION

This collection of photo albums and pictures was donated to the Hastings County Historical Society in March, 1998 by Margaret Preston of R.R. 1, Ameliasburgh, Ontario K0K 1AO. She had inherited the collection from her late father-in-law, Leslie Preston, who resided near the corner of Pine and Charles streets. Leslie Preston had obtained the materials at an auction sale some years ago when he bought them because he wished to have the trunk they were in. Presumably, the sale involved the estate of Leo Arthur Young, who resided at 4 Pine Street, Belleville.

This album appears to have been Viola Frost's album. She married Arthur Young in 1924. The only dated pictures are 1917 and 1918, but they probably extend into the 1920s.

The leather covered album is marked "Simcoe Photo Album 1307" and was made in Canada. Pictures cover the years from 1911 to 1962.

Right hand pages are from 1919 to mid 1920s and were apparently filled first; they are numbered from 1 to 50. Left-hand pages contain mostly more recent material; they are numbered from 51 to 100 and from the back of the book to front. A few later pictures were glued in (i.e. page 9).

Removable Magic Tape has been used to hold pictures in place until they can be catalogued.

9. LOOSE PICTURES and PICTURE DATING

9.1 Introduction

A substantial number of pictures were not mounted in albums, but were loose. They have been catalogued in this manner:

1. Original Captions (on front or back) are in quotation marks.
2. Comments by Gerry Boyce, Lois Foster and others in 1998 are indented.
3. Pictures are in envelopes or filing folders.
4. Pictures have not been assigned separate numbers at this time.
5. Some pictures have not been given individual descriptions, particularly if they relate to the United States (New York, Michigan, etc.). Rather, there is a brief description of the entire contents of the envelope or file folder.
6. Envelopes or file folders are arranged by:
 - . year/month/day (wherever possible)
 - . film development code (usually indicated by pencil or ink stamp on the reverse side)

2. 9.2 The Dating Game

1. Although some pictures in the collection are dated (either by the Youngs – on the fronts or backs of the pictures – or the photographic developer), many are not dated.
2. It is possible to estimate the dates on many of the pictures by means of the developers' numbers on the backs of pictures. In many early photographs, the developer placed a pencil number on the back to identify pictures from the same roll. In later cases, a number was stamped on the back using a numbering stamp and an inkpad. Some of the early photos developed in larger cities were stamped with an ink number, before that practice replaced the pencil marking in Belleville.
3. By means of the numbers on the backs of photographs, it should be possible to recreate parts or even all of certain rolls of film. This would provide links between pictures and help date "undated" pictures and identify "unidentified" people, locations, and events.
4. Unfortunately, it is difficult to do this for all pictures, since many are pasted into the albums.
5. The following is the beginning of a master list of film development codes. Use these codes and picture descriptions to better identify pictures in the albums.

9.3 Dated Pictures with Developers' Codes on Backs

1. The four columns at the left are for pictures in the LOOSE PICTURE Collection. The photographs are arranged by year in this priority arrangement:
 1. year marked by Youngs but no developer number on back
[these are indicated as "Nil"]
 2. numerically
 3. alphabetically
2. The two columns at the extreme right (5 and 6) indicate codes that are found in the four albums, but not in the Loose Collection. These codes have been included to provide a complete list of all known codes in the collection for which dates can be assigned.

9.4 Undated Pictures with Developers' Codes on Backs

These pictures relate to a variety of people and activities. There is inadequate information currently to allow them to be placed in the year files. Some can be accurately dated once the developing codes on the backs are related to pictures (with known dates) in the albums. This could be done before pictures are assigned HC numbers in order to keep similar pictures together.

9.4.1 Numbered but (normally) No Names

Developing codes on the backs of the loose pictures listed at left are related to pictures (with known dates) in the albums. This is a complete list of visible codes for all pictures in the albums. Unfortunately, many pictures were glued in and their codes are not visible.

The column at right identifies pictures in the albums that have the same developing codes.
