

2. Originally a toll bridge, the Bay Bridge became a free bridge and part of the province's road system on Dominion Day, 1921. Later, a causeway replaced most of the 17 original spans. The swing section was opened periodically during the navigation season to allow boats to pass, much to the annoyance of motorists.
