Most of them are of historic buildings, mostly in the area but there are also a large number that are of historic events. There are also additional prints of different themes such as reproductions of traditional Inuit artwork.
- G.B. 92** – See file GerryBoyce'sSlides1. Contains a large collection of photo slides. These slides include historic buildings in Belleville, area churches, historic photos of Belleville, cemeteries in Belleville, Mackenzie Bowell and other famous locals, and the schools located within the city.
- G.B. 93** – A continuation of G.B. 92, this box also contains a large collection of photo slides. Contains such subjects as Belleville's city hall, Native Americans, and the Gold Rush.
- G.B. 94** – Contains a large number of photographs and scans of historic sketches or photographs. Mostly consists of historic Belleville with a large section dedicated to churches. It also contains personal photographs, and photographs of the Historical Society.
- G.B. 95** – This box contains mostly historic photos and copies of historic photos. Most of these are themed around local people though some are also associated with buildings. There is a large section containing among the photos, notes for Gerry's gold rush book and a large section on schools. Other notable sections include that on the rebellion of 1837, railways and the military.
- G.B. 96** – This box contains a very large section on churches, focusing on St. Andrew's Presbyterian in Belleville. There are also pieces from other local churches. This section includes news bulletins, pamphlets, news paper clippings and historical write ups. There is also a very large section on genealogy consisting of correspondence and family histories. There are also 4 binders labelled; Historical Society Archives, HCHS Catalogue Letman Picture Collection, HCHS Catalogue Young Picture Collection and HCHS Catalogue Map Collection '98.
- G.B. 97** – This box is a collection of bound materials and includes; Lieut. Henry- Simmons' Journal 1777-1778, The Bones of David Redding, publications on genealogical records,, Frontenac Papers Index 1819-1831, Jean Richard U.E. of Isle Tanti, family histories, marriage registers, baptismal records, 1851 Prince Edward County Census, early church records, A book of many memories-the true life story of Veva Robson and the Liberal-Conservative Handbook 1911.

The author donated his time; however County Council presented him with a colour TV in appreciation.” (Additional material was placed in Society's Archives in Belleville Public Library including drafts and reader feedback.)

MG 3.1 Box 2: Hutton – Related to the publication of Hutton of Hastings: The Life and Letters of William Hutton, 1834-1861. “This book was published by Hastings County Council in recognition of the role of William Hutton, first warden of the Victoria District (the name by which Hastings County was known in the 1840s). The author donated his time; however County Council presented him with a console stereo and tape deck in appreciation.” (This material is especially important inasmuch as, since the deaths of Dorothy Sargent and her husband, Jack Sargent, the whereabouts of the original letters or any transcribed copies are unknown. Possibly passed into the hands of stamp collectors. Large sections of the transcripts are integrated within the author's draft explanatory text to indicate which sections (especially related to the family in Ireland and religion) were not included in the book.) Correspondence, proposals, drafts, proofs, research notes, full draft copy.

MG 3.2 Box 18: Heritage Groups – “Gerry Boyce served on the OHS Local Studies Committee from 1971 to 1973 and the executive of the OHS in 1972-1973.” “Originally known as the Quinte Historic Sites Association and then as the Quinte Historic and Parkway Association, this organization was established in 1957, largely through the efforts of Prof. Arthur R.M. Lower of Queen's University, Judge Gerald F. Smith of Napanee, and others. The association led the move to establish the Loyalist Parkway. For several years Gerry Boyce served on the executive as the representative for Hastings County (particularly the Hastings County Historical Society). The association held the occasional meeting in Hastings County, for example touring the 1838-39 County Court House when it was threatened with demolition circa 1960.” “On the recommendation of Dr. Richard Potter, a minister in the Progressive Conservative government, Gerry Boyce (though not a member of the P.C. Party) was appointed as a trustee of the ROM for a 3-year term, 1972-1975.”

MG 3.2 Box 19: Doors Open Belleville 2004-2006 – “In 2005 and 2006, Belleville participated in Doors Open Ontario. Gerry Boyce played a huge role in inaugurating this participation by contacting five agencies who acted as cosponsors of the event, as well as Belleville City Council. The agencies were: Heritage Belleville (on behalf of Belleville City Council), the Hastings County Historical Society, the Quinte Branch of the Architectural Conservancy of Ontario, the Belleville Chamber of Commerce, and the Belleville Business Improvement Area. Unfortunately, there was not enough support for a program in 2007.”

MG 3.3.1 Box 20: B.C.I. Research – “These files resulted from Gerry Boyce's plans to write a detailed study of the site set aside at Belleville in 1816 for a county grammar school. Four schools subsequently occupied the site: A Roman Catholic elementary school, Belleville Grammar School, Belleville High School, Belleville Collegiate Institute Catholic College. After Belleville City Council killed plans for the Quinte Cultural Centre to occupy the former BCIVS building, the Roman Catholic Separate School Board purchased the property, demolished the building (2004), and developed playing fields for students of St. Michael's Elementary School and Nicholson Catholic College.”

It was Gerry's intention to prepare a written history of education in Hastings County from these materials. However, the discovery of the William Hutton letters (in the possession of Dorothy Sargent of Ottawa) diverted him from his original goal. With the assistance of Hastings County Council and the Hastings County Historical Society, he prepared *Hutton of Hastings: The Life and Letters of William Hutton 1801-1861*, published by County Council as a Commemorative Project in 1972.
