The Carter collection relates to the Harrison family who resided at 64 Emily Street at Bleecker Avenue in Belleville. David Harrison married Margaret Elizabeth Harrison in 1873 and brought his family from England in 1886. He started as a blacksmith for the Grand Trunk Railway, Belleville and later became a superintendent with the CNR. He had 10 children in total with several sons also working for the railways in North America. His daughter Hannah Harrison (1889-1989) was born in Belleville and worked for a time as a milliner in Miss Maud Campbell's Hat shop. The family belonged to Tabernacle United Church in Belleville (Methodists).

Collection contained in one archival box with books, postcards, and some photographic material.
