10 Purdy Street - Sometime between 1915 and 1926 the Butterfields sold a strip of their property along Moira Street and a 1 1/2 story frame house was built thereon. When I looked at 10 Purdy Street on Jan. 26, 2002, the basic house is still there but not well looked after. There is now another small frame house on the corner of Purdy and Moira.

186 Moira Street - This house and its twin at 180 Moira are still there and the painted trim is quite fresh and nice but I don't think the tenants are looking after them very well. The houses are brick veneer.
