Hastings County Historical Society members have been recording some of the restoration work and donating photographs of the process to the Community Archives. On April 24th, work on the former Maze Mall building at 232 Front Street was recorded by Gerry Fraiberg, Barry Brown, and Gary Magarrell.

In the first picture here, taken in the morning of 24 April, half of the steel cladding formerly covering the building has been removed. By the time of the second photograph, taken in the afternoon of the same day, all of the building's original windows and details have been revealed.



Belleville McFarlands images

For the last year or two we have been working through the Community Archives' storage area, checking that everything on the shelves has a corresponding description in our online catalogue. In the process we are discovering items which have not previously been shared. Last month's find was a photograph album (2010-49) commemorating the Belleville McFarlands hockey team's trip to the Ice Hockey World Championships in Prague in March 1959, where they represented Canada.
