ST. JULIEN CHAPTER I.O.D.E.

Concert Group under Chairmanship of Mrs. R. Ellis

The St. Julien Chapter, I.O.D.E., was first organized in September 1915 and was named in honour of the brave men who fought at the battle of St. Julien, many of whom came from the counties of Hastings and Prince Edward.

Educational assistance is one of the chief concerns of the St. Julien Chapter. Each year a Grade 13 student of one of the secondary schools in Belleville receives a \$100 bursary to continue studies at a school of higher learning. Contributions are also made annually to National and Provincial War Memorial Scholarship Funds.

The St. Julien Chapter also awards a grant of \$25 to a Grade 12 student in each secondary school in Belleville who is the child of a naturalized Canadian, and who shows proficiency in English.
