Just one new addition last month...

On the one hand, December 2017 was a quiet month for new additions to the Community Archives, with only one new accession. On the other hand, it arrived at the Archives in a trailer and turned out to be one of the largest accessions of the year: it has certainly been keeping us busy!

The records belong to the Township of Stirling-Rawdon, which was formed in 1998 from the amalgamation of the Village of Stirling and Rawdon Township. Some of the records received in December date back to the 1840s.
